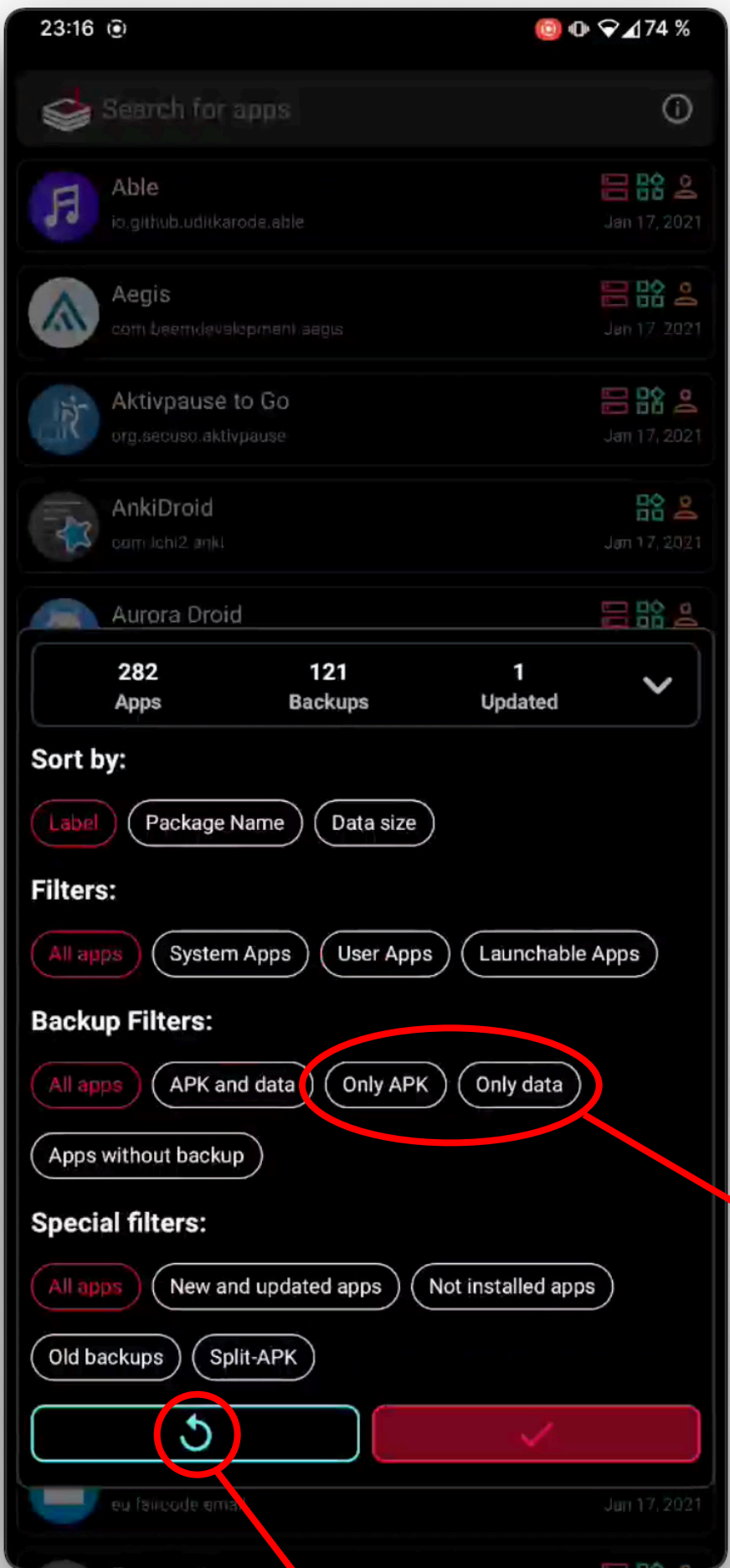
Info button contains a lot of information that isn't too relevant to helping the user understand the icons. Info button could be moved closer to the icons as it seems closely linked to the search function



Notification bubble very small – also doesn't tell users which app has been updated

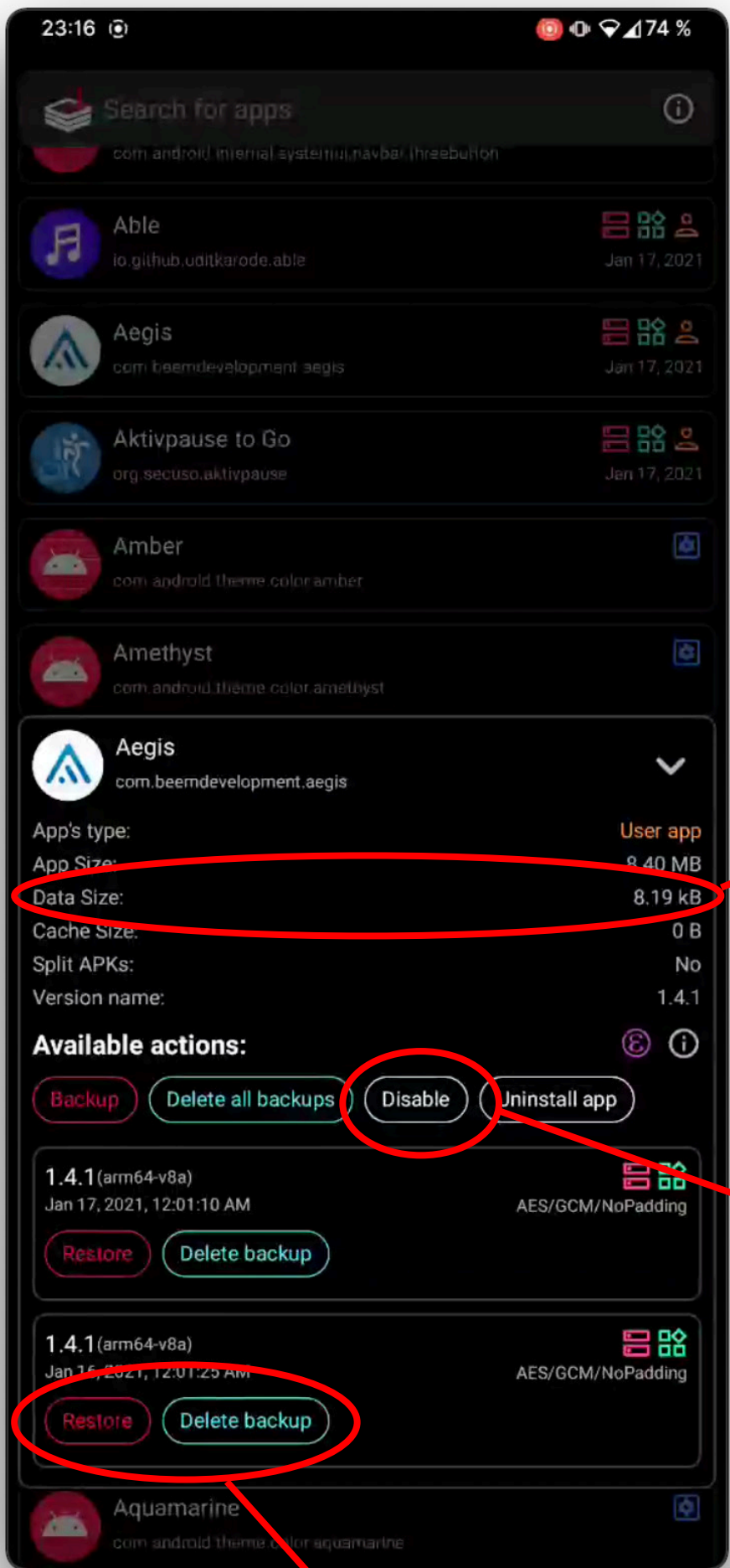
Nav bar has icons have small hitboxes and icons could do with supporting text to make navigation easier. Floating nav bar will also not be familiar to users as it is not consistent with common mobile navigation bar templates

Position of filter button may not be familiar to users as it is commonly located at the top of the list



Rephrasing as 'APK only' and 'Data only' or 'APK' and 'Data' would make it easier for users to visually identify filters quickly

Icon may be perceived as 'Undo' rather than reset filters. Supporting text may help this



Labels are located far from their value (e.g Data Size: and 8.19kB). Makes it harder to read data correctly and quickly

Not clear what enable / disable means? Changing the text could make it more obvious

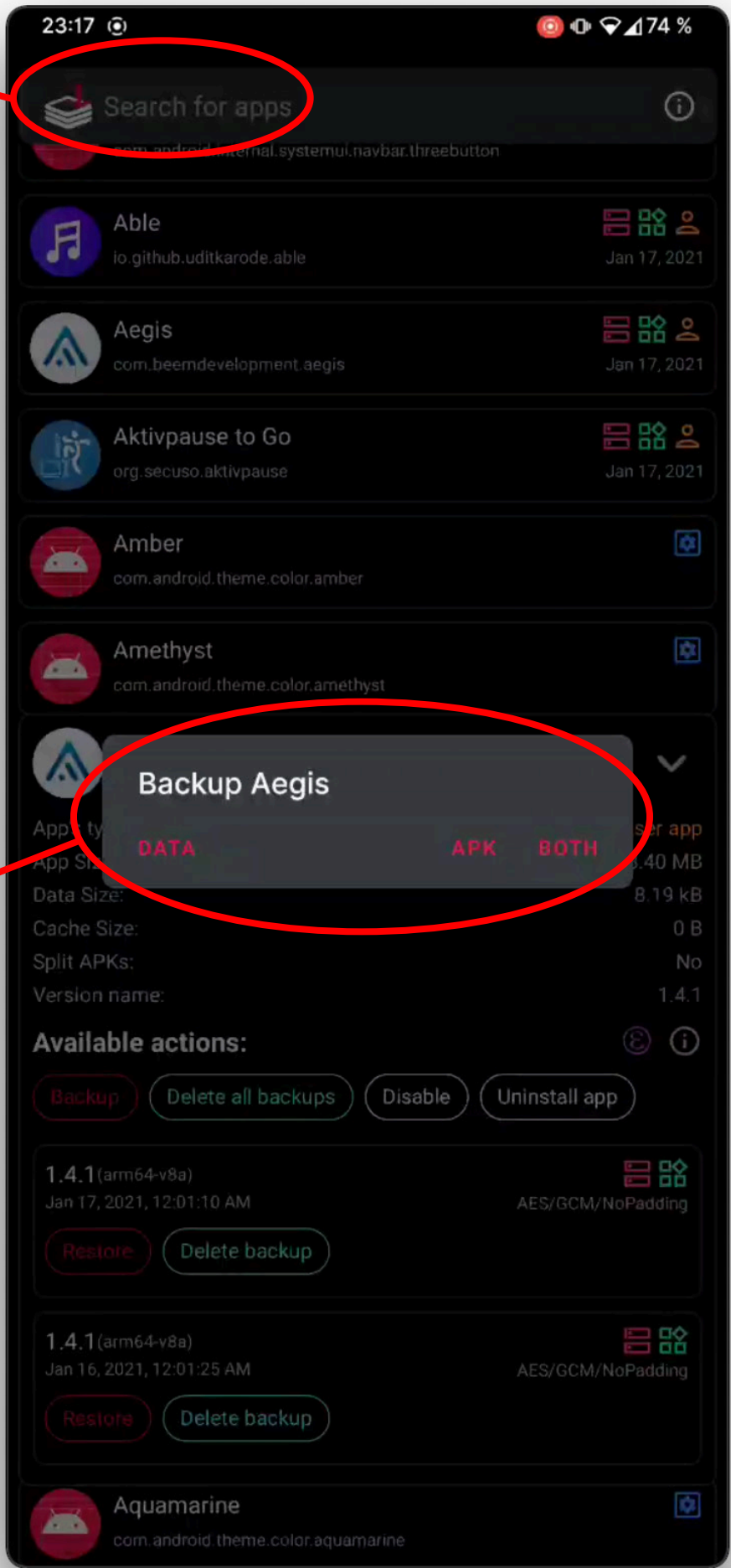
Colours used indicate that 'Restore' is a negative action and 'Delete backup' is a neutral action. Red is often associated with 'Delete' buttons so doesn't follow common usage

Backup Page

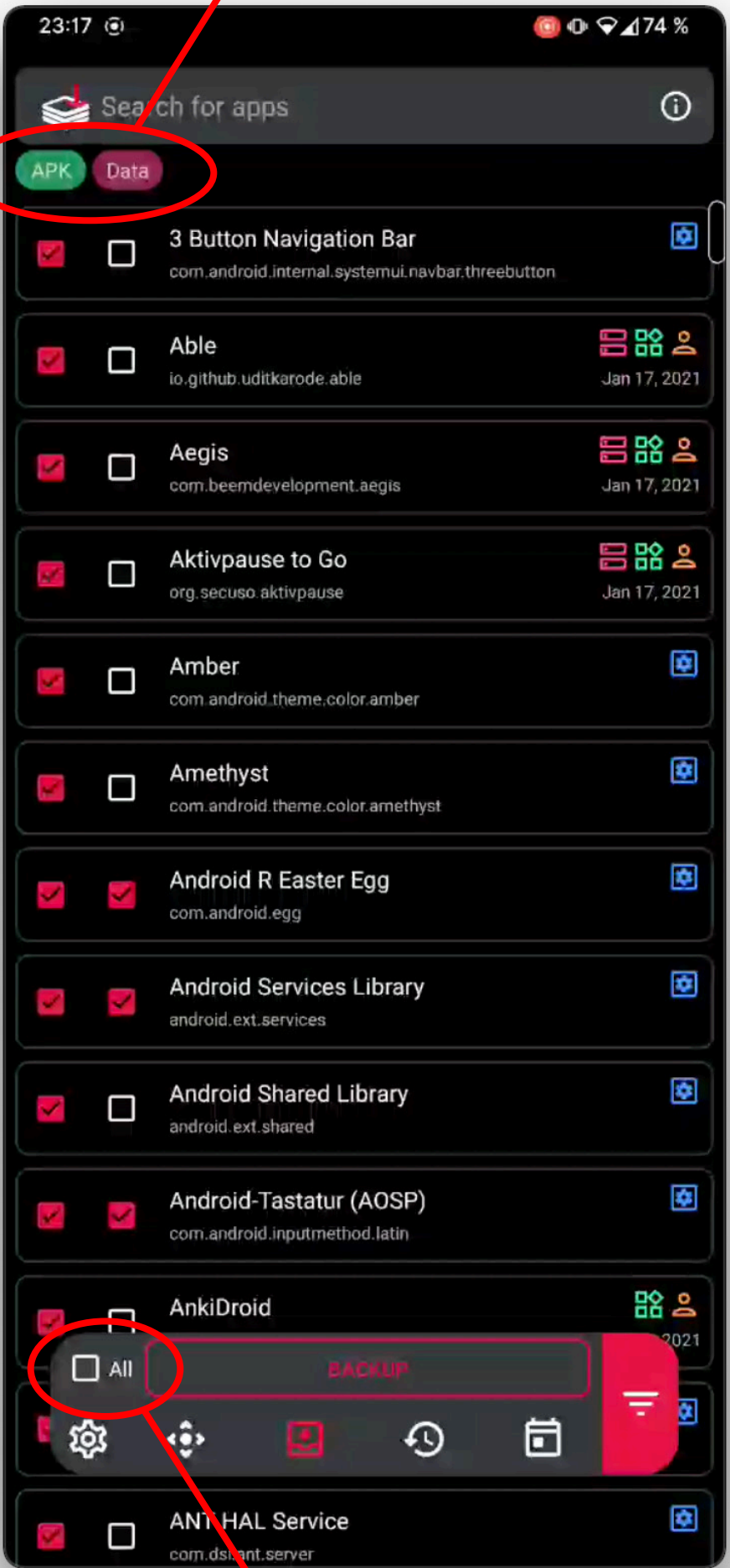
No page header - hard for users to tell where they are within the app. Especially as the home, backup and restore pages all look similar



Assuming that tapping anywhere else on the screen or pressing the back button will close the popup? If not, there needs to be a back or cancel option



Hit box is very small. They are also not styled like buttons, meaning they look more like headers than interactive elements

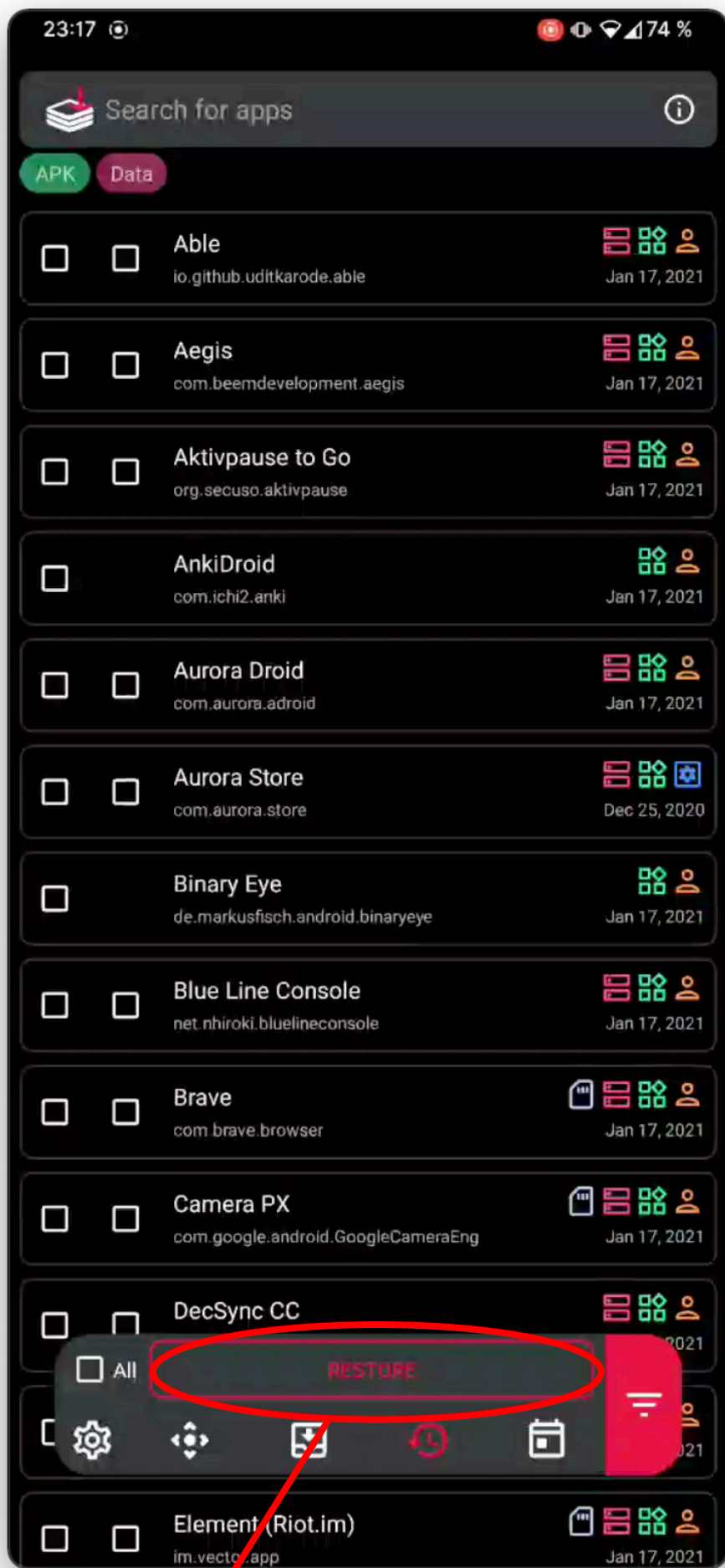


Position of 'All' checkbox feels slightly awkward. Relocating it may make it more intuitive

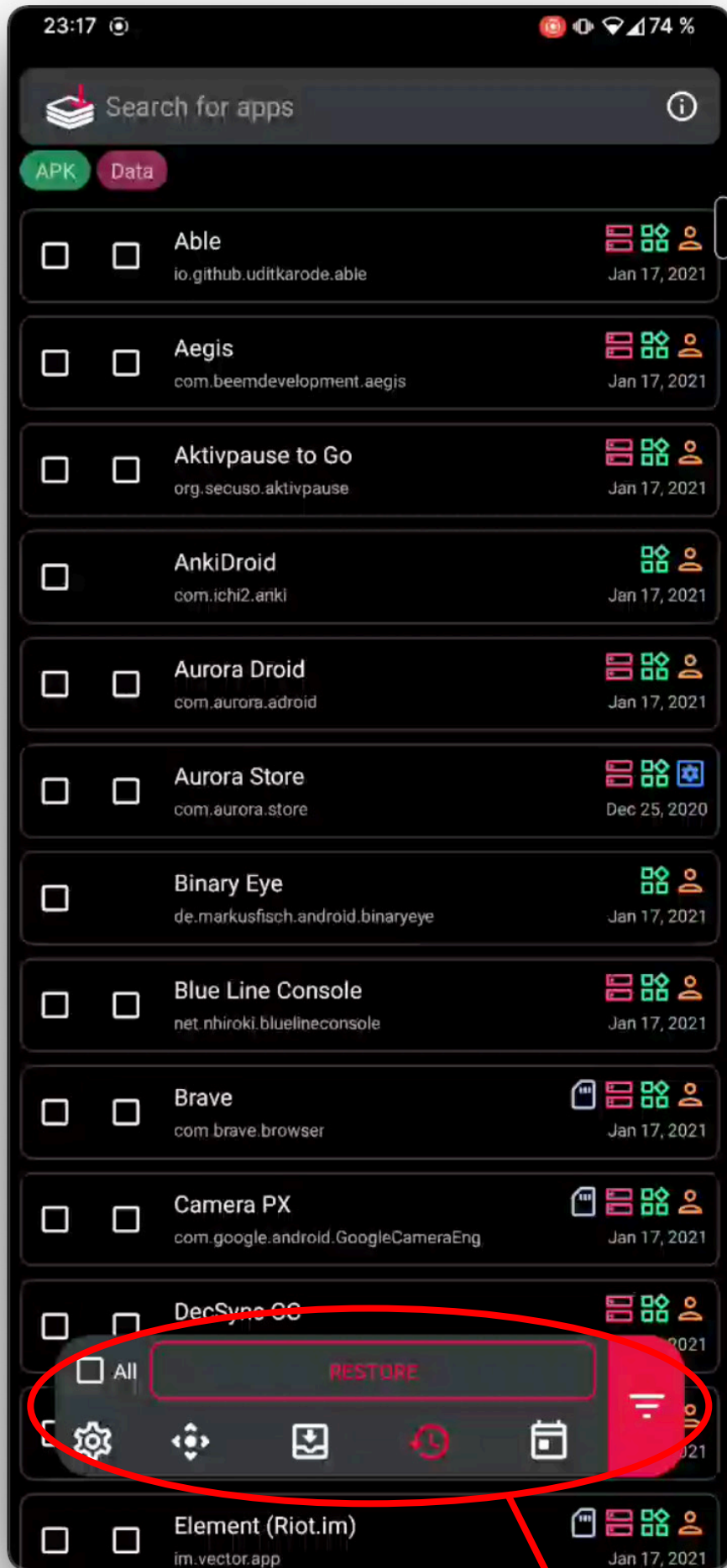


Restore Page

Height of popup box is too tall.
Limiting the height would help
position the No and Yes buttons
more centrally on the screen

then press 'restore'?



Navigation bar feels quite
crowded

Scheduling Page

'Hour of the day' text is slightly misleading as users can specify the minutes as well. 'Time of day' or 'Backup time' may be better.

'Time left' text could be clearer as it doesn't say what happens when the time runs out. 'Time until backup' or similar text may be better.

Icons used for custom list and blacklist are identical. Having different icons would make it easier to differentiate the buttons more quickly

Text is longer than needed - either 'Start backup' or 'Backup now' would be more concise and work just as well

Enable / disable schedule as a tick box not slightly confusing as the checkboxes are used as selectors elsewhere in the app. Maybe a toggle switch would be more appropriate?

Icons for APK and Data could be used here like on the other screens to help strengthen the type of backup and provide a more consistent experience

No option to undo deletion if accidentally pressed. Could frustrate users as the delete button is quite prominent.

Delete button may be better positioned within the schedule itself as it is unlikely users need to quickly delete multiple schedules

'Add schedule' button has quite a small hitbox. Location is not very intuitive
